Workshop on Brocades & other Inlay Techniques and Incorporating Tablet Weaving into Garments with Inge Dam

The workshop introduces students to various inlay techniques, such as brocading, bouton, twill inlay, Minor's inlay, dukagang, and glit (Icelandic inlay). Inlay on plain weave and twill weave ground structures will also be explored.

Students will also learn how to make a tablet warp and how to arrange it beside the fabric warp so the border and the fabric can be woven together using one shuttle.

Workshop begins on Friday, January 9, 2009 at 5:30 pm to 8:30 pm and continues on Saturday, January 10 thru Sunday, January 11 from 9 am to 4 pm at the UH Manoa Campus, Art Department, Fiber Room.
